

# Little Cities

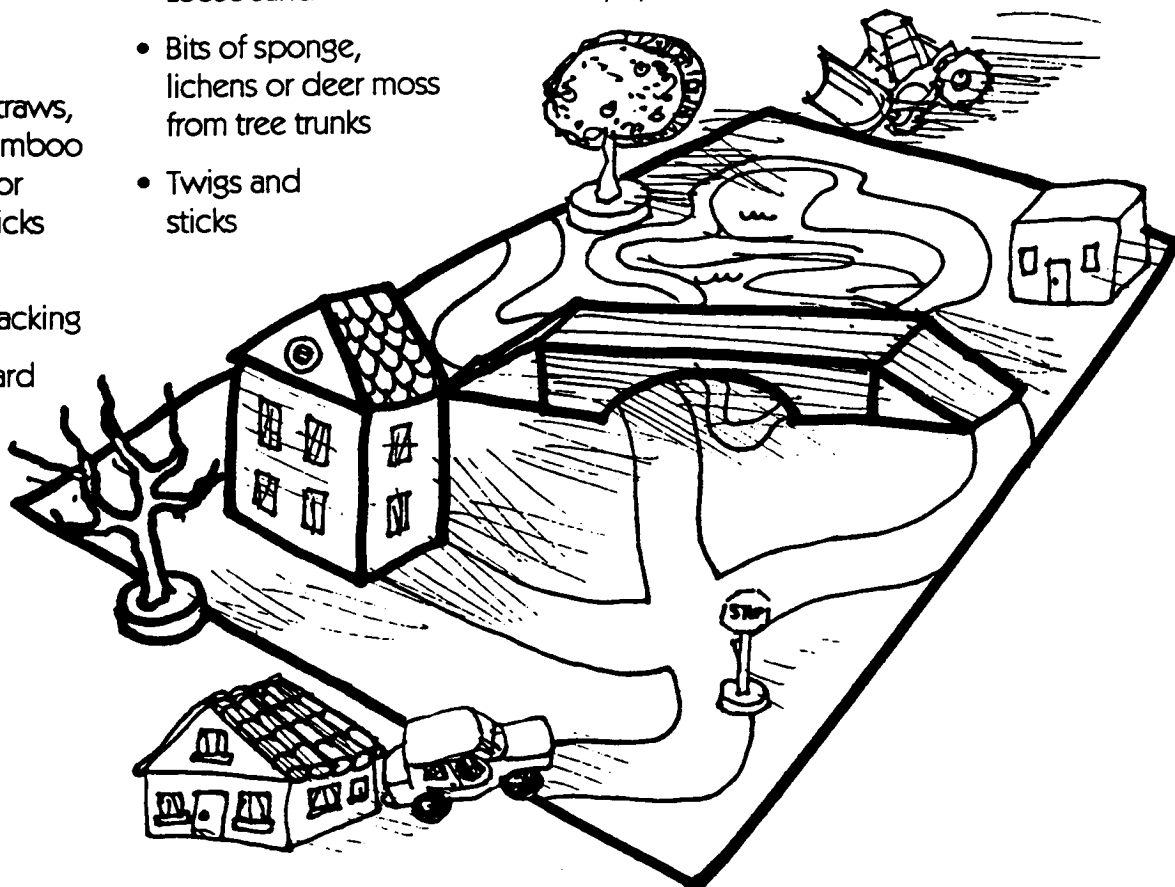

## Materials:

- Small blocks and pieces of wood
- Wallpaper scrap (end of roll) or any large paper
- Tiny toy cars
- Matchsticks, straws, toothpicks, bamboo skewers, and/or frozen treat sticks
- Chunks of polystyrene packing
- Small cardboard boxes
- Clear, thin plastic from lids, produce boxes, or bakery boxes
- Loose sand
- Bits of sponge, lichens or deer moss from tree trunks
- Twigs and sticks

## Tools:

- White glue
- Scissors
- Ruler (optional)
- Sandpaper
- Permanent markers or crayons
- Paint brushes (optional)
