

Paper Mold 1 Instructions, cont'd.

2 Pulling the screen tautly to the bottom of the frame, put the second staple in the center of the bottom.

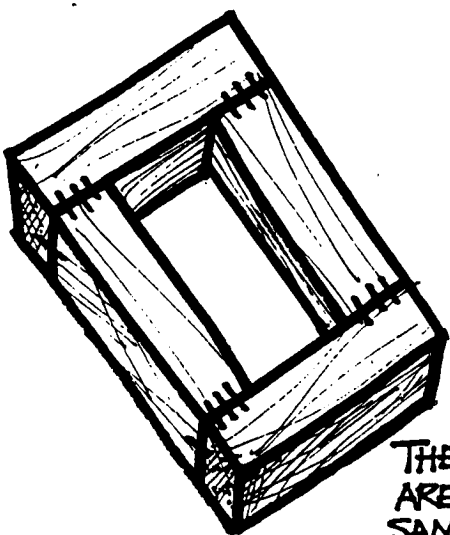
3 Pull the screen tautly to the side, (not quite as tight as you pulled to the bottom, because you still have the other side to do,) place staple number three in the center of the frame side.

4 Pull tautly to the other side, put the fourth staple in the center of that side.

5 For the fifth staple, return to the top where you put staple number one and put it about 1/4" away from staple one.

6 Place staple six next to staple number two, (see diagram on front for staple placement.) As you work your way around the frame stapling the screen on, you should now be pulling the corners taut, until all of your mold screen is attached to the frame and taut, (like the top of a drum).

7 When all of your screen is stapled on, you're finished with your mold and deckle and ready to go make paper!



THESE SCRAPS ARE ALL THE SAME LENGTH!

If you don't have any old frames, get some scrap lumber pieces all the same thickness and length. Staple the pieces together front and back as shown at left.

Remember you need eight pieces, not four, because you will need to make two frames! Use waterproof glue in the corners to reinforce them.
